CONSTRUCTION DETAIL

Weekday Work: 7 a.m. – 5 p.m.

- Project wide activities
 - Platform shelter and handrail Installations
 - Topsoil installation and irrigation testing
 - Drainage hole cutting in rails
- Howell
 - Overhead electrical wiring at Howell
- Madison to Columbia
 - Sidewalk restoration on Madison between Boylston and Broadway
- Minor intersection
 - Overhead electrical wiring

Weekend work: 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.

- Electrical substation installation on Howell
- Asphalt paving at Union
- Asphalt paving James to Boren

Traffic Advisories

Mar. 15:

- Howell will be closed between Broadway and Nagle to install electrical substation
- The east leg of the intersection of Jefferson and Broadway will be closed for paving
- The east and west legs of the intersection of James and Broadway will be closed for paving.

What to Expect During Construction:

- On street parking and loading restrictions
- Increased truck traffic
- Traffic and pedestrian detours
- Construction noise and dust
- Odors from asphalt paving
