Center City Connector

In preparation for the Center City Connector, we will be performing utility location work at and near intersections along 1st Ave starting at Jackson St and moving north to Stewart St.

Crews plan to begin work on **Wednesday, November 2**. We expect work to take about **4 to 5 weeks**. Crews will be working on weekdays and some weekends. The approximate schedule, subject to change, is below.

- 1st Ave S and S Jackson St
- 1st Ave S and S Main St
- 1st Ave S and S Washington St
- 1st Ave S and Yesler Way
- 1st Ave S and Cherry St

- 1st Ave and Marion St
- 1st Ave and Madison St

During this work, you should expect:

- Temporary lane restrictions and pedestrian detours
- Additional noise and truck activity
- Short-term/temporary parking restrictions with 72-hour notice
- Weekday work between the hours of 9 AM and 3 PM
- Some weekend work between the hours of 9 AM and 5 PM
- No work on Nov 20 and Dec 4, and no afternoon work on Nov 7
